2011 American Fork Steel Days Art Show Rules

1. Entries must be the original work of the participating artist. Pre-drawn and/or color by number projects or copies are not eligible.
2. Entries prepared in a class, workshop, or with the help of an instructor are not eligible in novice and experienced divisions.
3. Entries must have been completed within the past three years. Work previously entered in the Steel Days Art Show may not be entered again.
4. Experienced and Novice entries must be framed. Youth and Children's entries may be framed, matted, or mounted on card stock. Framed artwork must have wire extended across the back that is securely fastened to eye screws on either side of the frame. Purchased frames with saw-tooth hangers are not acceptable.
5. The maximum size limit for all two-dimensional work is not to exceed 48 inches, including the frame. This will ensure that the piece is compatible with our hanging system.
6. If the entrant in the novice division has taken a First Place award for three consecutive years, that entrant will be required to place their work in a higher division.
7. Artists may receive no more than one "Place" award in each category. Honorable Mention(s) may be awarded in addition to the "Place" award.
8. In the event that there are insufficient entries in a category for judging to occur, one of the following will apply: the piece will be grouped with similar works or a "special award" ribbon will be given and the work eligible for entry in next year's show. Note: "Regrouping" of artwork will be done at the discretion of the Show Director.
9. All entries must remain on display for the duration of the show.
10. Artwork deemed unworthy of consideration or not suitable for our community oriented exhibit will be rejected.
