

**ORDINANCE NO. 2017-04-25**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 1.20 OF AMERICAN FORK CITY, UTAH, RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated §10-3-208 and 20A-9-203, each candidate for municipal office shall file with the municipal clerk or recorder a declaration of candidacy and a campaign finance statement; and

**WHEREAS**, the American Fork City Council desires to bring the Municipal Code into compliance with the State Code as it relates to certain provisions for municipal elections.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF AMERICAN FORK CITY, STATE OF UTAH:**

**PART 1**

**TEXT OF ORDINANCE**

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 1.20.040 entitled Campaign finance disclosure in municipal elections is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1.20.040. - Campaign finance disclosure in municipal elections adopted by reference.

All provisions of Utah Code Annotated Section 10-3-208, which pertain to campaign finance disclosures in municipal elections, are adopted and incorporated by reference.

**PART II**

**PROVISIONS AND ADOPTION**

**SECTION 1.** Severability

The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable. If any such section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of constitutionality of any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** Amendment to be added to the City Code.

The City Council hereby authorizes and directs that insert pages reflecting the provisions enacted hereby shall be made and placed in the City Code.

**SECTION 3. Effective Date**


This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.
