



10th – 12th Grade COED Soccer –Tournament Rules

Teams and Participants:

- All players **must** be registered with American Fork Recreation and your team.
- A game will be considered a forfeit if a team plays any portion of a game with a player, who is not properly registered on that team.
- Protest regarding ineligible participants on opposing teams must be done prior to the games finish.

Tournament game rules:

Games consists of 2, 25 minute halves.

“IF” will consist of 2, 15 minutes halves and played on same day as bracket final.

Game time is start time. Games may begin with as few as 4 players. No forfeit will be declared until the end of the first half. A forfeit will be declared if a team has less than 6 players, two of which must be of the opposite gender.

8 v 8 format: A maximum of 8 players may be on the field during game play. A maximum of 4 male players and 4 female players on the field at any time.

The goalkeeper may be either male or female.

Slide tackling is PROHIBITED – If the official stops play, a direct kick awarded to offended team.

If a Female scores a goal, her team will be awarded 2 points. If a male scores a goal, his team will be awarded 1 point.

Only female kickers will be allowed to take penalty kicks. If a goal is scored off on a penalty kick, the team will only be awarded 1 point.

Offside rule will not be enforced.

Games that end in a “Tie” will be decided by a shootout.

1- The shootout takes place 12 yards from the goal.

2- Each team chooses 2 male & 2 female players from their team to kick. Opposing team will provide a female goalkeeper vs a female kicker and a male goalkeeper for a male kicker.

3- All goals during the shootout will be 1 point.

4- In case of a tie after all eight attempts, a sudden death shootout would follow. A female kicker that had not already kicked must begin from each team and alternating to a male kicker until a winner is decided.
